**Readings (June 21, 2020) 12TH SUNDAY ORD.TIME**

*Jeremiah 20:10-13* (Jeremiah expresses confidence that the Lord will protect him.)

*Romans 5:12-15* (Sin came into the world through one person; so salvation came through one person for many.)

*Matthew 10:26-33* (Jesus assures the Twelve that God cares about them.)

**Background on the Gospel Reading**

We read today's Gospel in the context of last week's Gospel in which Jesus sent the twelve disciples to proclaim the kingdom of heaven. In between last week's reading and today's reading, Jesus has predicted that the disciples will face difficulties in their mission. Many people will not receive them well, even within the land of Israel. Even family members will turn away from the disciples because of the disciples' commitment to Jesus and the kingdom. Today's Gospel offers the disciples consolation against this difficult truth. This section of Matthew's Gospel should be read in the context of Matthew's intended audience, a Jewish-Christian community. The Gospel alludes to the dangers and persecutions that this community has most likely already faced and will continue to face. To reassure this community, Matthew recalls for them the

encouraging words of Jesus that we read today. In this Gospel passage, Jesus might be understood as putting suffering in perspective. The disciples of Jesus are called upon to keep their focus on God. Those who can harm the body do not have ultimate power; God does. Still persecution and suffering can not be avoided or prevented. But Jesus reassures his disciples that God knows and cares about what happens to his children. We might not face the same type of persecution, but we do experience difficulties as we endeavor to live a Christian life. Sometimes we let the opinions of others prevent us from doing what we know to be right. We need the reminder that what God thinks about us is more important. We are reassured by the promise that God cares for us and protects us.

## Directives Concerning Church Operations During Pandemic:

With the recent announcement from the Ontario government that places of worship may once again open with 30% capacity; the Roman Catholic Diocese of Peterborough is now preparing to reopen its parishes reverently and responsibly. To begin the reopening process, our parish will follow this timeline:

June 13–15 – Period of preparation for our parish. Church will remain closed.

June 14—On the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, parishes will open church building for a period of the day for private prayer, sacrament of reconciliation and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament from 12noon till 2:00pm. These parish devotional activities are held only in Cardiff.

June 15—churches closed for necessary cleaning and preparation

June 16—Priests begin to celebrate daily Masses in parishes. (refer bulletin schedule)

June 20/21– Sunday Masses will resume. (refer bulletin schedule)

The procedures for the celebration of Mass and the sacraments will be different from our usual experience. I ask for your understanding and patience as we welcome back our parishioners, even in limited numbers. This will be a period of transition and adjustment as we begin the reopening process. Parishioners are asked to self-screen before attending church, including taking their temperature. Those with a temperature above 37.5 C are asked to not attend Mass. Those who exhibit fever, or any other indications of a viral infections are asked to seek medical attention before coming to church. In order to mitigate the potential spread of the virus, the Chief Medical Officer for the Province of Ontario, is asking that all those over the age of 3 wear a mask/face covering when physical distancing is challenging. While not mandatory, they are highly recommended. Should anyone present with COVID-19 symptoms and become ill during Mass, they will be advised to leave and seek medical assistance. Churches should always be clean and tidy; however, in times of pandemic, extra care and attention must be taken to ensure that surfaces remain as clean as possible to reduce the transmission of infection. Each parishioner will be directed to sanitize their hands before entering and exiting the church.

Fr. Vic is asking for cleaning assistance from volunteers. The volunteers must follow the Volunteer Screening Guidelines for the Roman Catholic Diocese of Peterborough. Fr. Vic will provide the volunteer cleaning brigade with the disinfectant cleaning materials, gloves, and a face mask and/or a face shield. During the pandemic we ask that you practice physical distancing while entering or exiting the church. Parishioners attending at Mass are advised not to sing due to the heightened potential spreading of airborne contagion. So unfortunately, there will be no singing. The monetary collection will be omitted; however, a basket will be placed outside the exit door where, as people are exiting, they can place their donations, supervised by an usher from a safe distance. At this time, Holy Communion will be distributed by the priest only, in hand. Parishioners are instructed to leave the church without spending social

time with the priest and fellow parishioners at the door or in the parking lot.

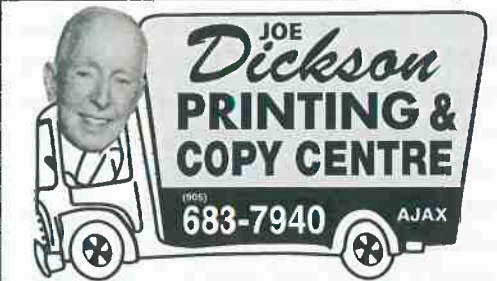
