Readings (June 28, 2020) 13TH SUNDAY ORD. TIME

2 Kings 4:8-11, 14-16a (Hospitality extended to Elisha will be rewarded.)

Romans 6:3-4, 8-11 (Through Christ we are dead to sin but alive in God.)

Matthew 10:37-42 (Jesus outlines the costs and rewards of discipleship.)

Background on the Gospel Reading

Today's Gospel is the conclusion of the instructions and consolations that we have heard Jesus offering to his disciples during the past few weeks. In this passage, Jesus summarizes both the costs of discipleship and its rewards. Once again our understanding of the Gospel is strengthened by considering the context in which it was written and the perspective of Matthew's audience. The conditions of discipleship outlined in Matthew's Gospel may appear harsh. Yet they underline for us a truth—choosing anything with one's whole heart has consequences. Choosing life with Christ means that every relationship we have must be understood from a new perspective. For many in Matthew's community, this choice brought division to their family. Matthew also outlines the reward

of hospitality offered to Jesus' followers. In today's Gospel, Jesus explains the difficulties of discipleship, yet reveals that those who welcome the disciples have also welcomed him. Today's Gospel also highlights for us the importance of hospitality in the Christian life. To welcome another in Jesus' name is to extend hospitality to Jesus himself. We have many opportunities in our daily life to reach out to others, to be a welcoming presence and a sign of God's love.

Directives Concerning Church Operations During Pandemic:

The procedures for the celebration of Mass and the sacraments will be different from our usual experience. I ask for your understanding and patience as we welcome back our parishioners, even in limited numbers. This will be a period of transition and adjustment as we begin the reopening process. Parishioners are asked to self-screen before attending church, including taking their temperature. Those with a temperature above 37.5 C are asked to not attend Mass. Those who exhibit fever, or any other indications of a viral infections are asked to seek medical attention before coming to church. In order to mitigate the potential spread of the virus, the Chief Medical Officer for the Province of Ontario, is asking that all those over the age of 3 wear a mask/face covering when physical distancing is challenging. While not mandatory, they are highly recommended. Should anyone present with COVID-19 symptoms and become ill during Mass, they will be advised to leave and seek medical assistance. Churches should always be clean and tidy; however, in times of pandemic, extra care and attention must be taken to ensure that surfaces remain as clean as possible to reduce the transmission of infection. Each parishioner will be directed to sanitize their hands before entering and exiting the church.

Fr. Vic is asking for cleaning assistance from volunteers. He will provide the volunteer cleaning brigade with the disinfectant cleaning materials, gloves, and a face mask. During the pandemic we ask that you practice physical distancing while entering or exiting the church. Parishioners attending at Mass are advised not to sing due to the heightened potential spreading of airborne contagion. So unfortunately, there will be no singing. The monetary collection will be omitted; however, a basket will be placed outside the exit door where, as people are exiting, they can place their donations, supervised by an usher from a safe distance. At this time, Holy Communion will be distributed by the priest only, in hand. Parishioners are instructed to leave the church without spending social time with the priest and fellow parishioners at the door or in the parking lot.

He will call on me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble, I will deliver him and honor him. With long life I will satisfy him and show him my salvation."

We don't even know what to do anymore, we feel confused and uncertain about the future. We wonder sometimes if you're really listening. Life seems to have taken us so far away. Please help us to come back to you. Bring us safely under the shelter of your wings. Thank you that you alone are our fortress, we find protection and rest in you today. In Jesus' Name.
