Readings Next Week (Sept. 06, 2020) 23rd SUNDAY

Ezekiel 33:7-9 (The Son of Man is appointed as guardian of Israel.)

Romans 13:8-10 (The Law is summarized in the commandment to love your neighbor as yourself.)

Matthew 18:15-20 (Jesus teaches his disciples how to settle disputes in the Church.)

Background on the Gospel Reading

Today's Gospel reading is taken from a chapter of Matthew's Gospel, which is sometimes called the "discourse on the Church" or the "church order" discourse. In this part of Matthew's Gospel, Jesus speaks more directly about matters of Church discipline and order. In today's reading we find one of only three instances in which Jesus

uses the word *church* in Matthew's Gospel. In Matthew's record of Jesus' teaching, we can hear echoes of the kinds of issues faced by the early Christian community. In the first part of the "discourse on the Church" (Matthew 18:1-14), Matthew addresses the Christian community's concerns about rank. Jesus responds to the disciples' question about who is greatest in the kingdom of heaven. Jesus indicates that those who wish to enter the kingdom of heaven must be like children, and he cautions those leaders who might lead these "little ones" astray. He also responds with the parable of the lost sheep, indicating how God will seek out and bring back those "little ones" who have strayed. In today's Gospel reading, Matthew 18:15-20, Jesus addresses a common occurrence in the Christian community: a dispute between two members of the Church. Jesus outlines a procedure for settling such matters fairly. The victim should privately address the offender and attempt to resolve the dispute without outside involvement. If that fails, then the victim should bring two or three witnesses and confront the offender again. If the dispute is still unresolved, the matter should be brought to the attention of the entire community. If the offender refuses to adhere to the reparations prescribed by the community, then Jesus suggests that the offender may be expelled from the Church. Jesus does not discourage disagreement within the community of the Church; he acknowledges the reality of conflict and error and offers his disciples a means for addressing such matters. It is in the conclusion to this teaching that the message of hope is found: Jesus is present with the community and will guide the community in its relations. If decisions are taken in prayer, then the community can be assured of God's assistance.

Pontifical Collection for the Custody of the Holy Land September 12/13

As you know, the date for the Pontifical Collection for the Holy Land was changed by our Holy Father Francis to the 13th of September. He especially chose this Sunday because it was the day before the feast of the Exaltation of the Cross. That feast while celebrating Christ's saving work also calls to mind faithful Christians, like St. Helen when she found the relics of the Holy Cross in the 4th century, who have committed themselves to preserving the holy sites as places of worship that have sustained and continue to sustain our Christian culture and salvation history. The annual Holy Land Collection not only helps to maintain churches and shrines located at holy sites, but , above all, helps to support the pastoral, welfare, educational and social works that the Church undertakes in caring for the local population. Our Holy Father, Pope Francis, invites you to be in solidarity with the Church and the Christians in the Holy Land.

CATECHISM FOR A YEAR

209. What is meant by the term "heaven"?
By "heaven" is meant the state of supreme and definitive happiness. Those who die in the grace of God and have no need of further purification are gathered around Jesus and Mary, the angels and the saints. They thus form the Church of heaven, where they see God "face to face" (*1 Corinthians 13:12*). They live in a communion of love with the Most Blessed Trinity and they intercede for us.

210. What is purgatory?
Purgatory is the state of those who die in God's friendship, assured of

their eternal salvation, but who still have need of purification to enter into the happiness of heaven.

211. How can we help the souls being purified in purgatory?
Because of the communion of saints, the faithful who are still pilgrims on earth are able to help the souls in purgatory by offering prayers in suffrage for them, especially the Eucharistic sacrifice. They also help them by almsgiving, indulgences, and works of penance.

Respect for the Planet's Resources: We pray that the planet's resources will not be plundered, but shared in a just and respectful manner.

THE POPE SPEAKS TO OUR HEARTS

The gift of the Risen Christ: The life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me (Galatians 2:20). What is this life? It is God's own life. And who brings us this life? It is the Holy Spirit, the gift of the Risen Christ. The Spirit leads us into the divine life as true children of God, as sons and daughters in the only-begotten Son, Jesus Christ. Are we open to the Holy Spirit? Do we let ourselves be guided by him?

God Is Your Intimate Friend: When we hear God, do we list to an intimate Friend or a distant friend only casually acquainted with us? A distant friend may give ear to our prayers if we happen to be interested in the same things he's concerned about, but an intimate Friend is one who listens, whether or not the subject matter is of great interest. Understanding God as an intimate friend or as a distant acquaintance influences the degree of openness we have in our conversations with Him. "Be my intimate Friend, dear Lord. Walk with me. Talk with me. Let us share together. I need a best Friend."
