**Readings Next week (Oct. 27, 2019) 30th Sunday**

*Sirach 35:12-14,16-18-God hears the prayer of the poor.*

*2 Timothy 4:6-8,16-18-Paul perseveres in faith, confident that God will rescue him.*

*Luke 18:9-14-Jesus tells the parable of the proud Pharisee who prayed from his self-importance and the tax collector who prayed humbly.*

**Background on the Gospel Reading**

The second parable that Jesus tells in Luke 18 addresses attitude in prayer. In contrasting the prayer of the Pharisee with the prayer of the tax collector, Jesus teaches his disciples to pray in humility before God. Jesus again surprises his listeners by showing the tax collector as the example of faith, rather than the Pharisee. Remember that Pharisees were members of a sect of Judaism active in Jesus' time. They taught an oral interpretation of the Law of Moses as the basis for Jewish piety. If anyone would be a model for prayer, a Pharisee was a likely candidate. In contrast, Jesus offers the tax collector as a model for prayer. Tax collectors were collaborators with the Roman authorities in a system that allowed the tax collectors to line their own pockets by charging in excess of the defined taxes. Yet, in this parable, Jesus offers the humility of the tax collector as a model for the prayer of a disciple. The parable reminds us that when we pray, we must remember our need for God in our lives. If we are too full of ourselves, there is too little room for God's grace to work in us.

**TREMENDOUS VALUE OF HOLY MASS**

**At the hour of death the holy Masses you have heard devoutly will be your greatest consolation. Every Mass will go with you to Judgement and will plead for pardon for you. By every Mass you can diminish the temporal punishment due to your sins, more or less, according to your fervor . (to be continued)**

**CATECHISM IN A YEAR 75. What was the first human sin?**  
When tempted by the devil, the first man and woman allowed trust in their Creator to die in their hearts. In their disobedience they wished to become "like God" but without God and not in accordance with God (Genesis 3:5). Thus, Adam and Eve immediately lost for themselves and for all their descendants the original grace of holiness and justice.

**76. What is original sin?** Original sin, in which all human beings are born, is the state of deprivation of original holiness and justice. It is a sin "contracted" by us not "committed"; it is a state of birth and not a personal act. Because of the original unity of all human beings, it is transmitted to the descendants of Adam "not by imitation, but by propagation". This transmission remains a mystery which we cannot fully understand.

***HAVE YOU EVER ATTENDED A PARISH MISSION? The Mission is just two weeks away. Have you decided to make it? Too busy? Heard it all before? You are beyond help because of divorce? Remarried? Haven't been to church in years? These are excuses (not reasons) for avoiding the Mission. Weigh them all against the generous love of God who wants to speak to you. No matter what your decision, can I ask you to pray about the Mission? Prayer, as you know, changes things. Pray for yourself, for others. God will not refuse a heart raised to him in sincere prayer. Prayer will do for us what no other force on earth can do..***

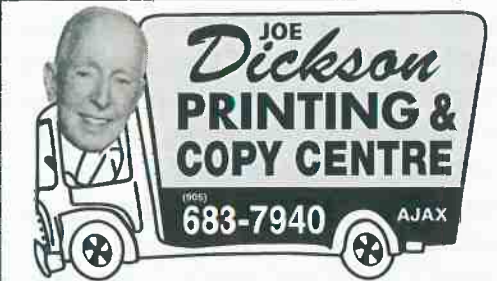
