Readings Next Week (Nov. 08, 2020) 32nd SUNDAY

Wisdom 6:12-16 (Wisdom will come to those who seek it.)

1 Thessalonians 4:13-18 (shorter form: 1 Thessalonians 4:13-14) God will raise all those who have died.

Matthew 25:1-13 (Jesus tells the parable of the wise and foolish virgins, teaching his disciples the importance of being prepared to receive the Kingdom of Heaven.)

Background on the Gospel Reading

In this week's Gospel, Jesus talks about what it means to be prepared to receive the Kingdom of Heaven. This week's reading follows a series of warnings and predictions by Jesus about the coming of the Son of Man. Jesus wants his disciples to understand that the exact day and time cannot be predicted. He teaches the disciples that they must remain vigilant so that they will not be caught unprepared. When thinking about the parable of the wise and foolish virgins, it is important to consider the first-century wedding traditions of Palestine. Scholars tell us that it was the custom of the day for young maidens—friends and family members of the bride—to meet the bridegroom when he came to bring his bride to her new home. As with many of Jesus' parables, several levels of interpretation are possible. In the chapter preceding this parable, however, Jesus warns about the destruction of Jerusalem, the tribulation of the end times, and the coming of the Son of Man. When read in this context, today's parable is a warning to the Christian community to remain vigilant and prepared to re-

ceive Jesus, the Son of Man who will return at the end of time. This interpretation is supported by the reference to the delay of the bridegroom. The Christian community for whom Matthew wrote this Gospel was coming to terms with the realization that the promise of Jesus' return would not be fulfilled within their lifetimes. The question remains for us to ask ourselves, Are we ready to receive Jesus? Will we be prepared to receive him?

During the month of November we celebrate Remembrance Day in commemoration of All the Faithful Departed particularly those who died during the wars in defense of freedom and liberty. Time for us to remember them in prayers. Consider offering special Masses for your deceased relatives and friends during this month. See Fr. Vic after Mass.

CATECHISM FOR A YEAR

- 214. In what does the final judgment consist?**
The final or universal judgment consists in a sentence of happiness or eternal condemnation, which the Lord Jesus will issue in regard to the "just and the unjust" (Acts 24:15) when he returns as the Judge of the living and the dead. After the last judgment, the resurrected body will share in the retribution which the soul received at the particular judgment.
- 215. When will this judgment occur?**
This judgment will come at the end of the world and only God knows the day and the hour.
- 216. What is the hope of the new heavens and the new earth?**
After the final judgment the universe itself, freed from its bondage to decay, will share in the glory of Christ with the beginning of "the new heavens" and a "new earth" (2 Peter 3:13). Thus, the fullness of the Kingdom of God will come about, that is to say, the definitive realization of the salvific plan of God to "unite all things in Christ, things in heaven and things of earth" (Ephesians 1:10). God will then be "all in all" (1 Corinthians 15:28) in eternal life.

The Road of Hope a gospel from prison by Cardinal Francis Xavier Nguyen Van Thuan

Be prepared to reject wealth and position—even to give up your own life— in order to preserve your ideals, your integrity and your faith. You must never behave otherwise, for to do so means to lose everything.

The Holy Spirit is committed and equipped to guide you. He will guide you according to truth. But He will not override your will and force you to follow. You have a part to play. And it begins with your mind.

To walk by the Spirit is to live with moment-by-moment dependency on and sensitivity to the initial prompting of the Holy Spirit. It is lifestyle.

"You lead and I will follow, Father . You are already my life, but I want to make walking in Your Spirit my lifestyle. Let me begin today."
