THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT MEDITATION**

THINK: Let's decorate! When we get ready for an event or celebration, we certainly prepare our minds and our hearts. But we prepare the outside too. We want what we see and touch to help us celebrate. Maybe we get dressed up or dressed in a uniform for the game. We clean and arrange our rooms and we decorate our homes as we prepare for a party or special dinner. Many of us like to decorate during this season. Making our surrounding beautiful and putting symbols on display is, in a way similar to what God does with this world that he's made. He fills it with beauty and color and life, which expresses his love, wisdom and wholeness—the joy that he promises the people of Israel, the joy of the wilderness and desert blooming once again. And so we think of Jesus coming, and we're happy about that. We're joyful and excited. We may be elaborate or we may take a simple path. Whatever we do, we're preparing for Jesus—blooming with joy with our whole selves and our whole lives, inside and out!

PRAY: Creator God, you have given us a beautiful world and a loving savior May we respond with lives of beauty, gratitude and joy.

DO: Spend some time talking about your favorite decorations for this season. Are there any new and different decorations anyone in the family would like to bring into your home? Work together to create something new! Maybe each family member could create a symbol that has special meaning for them.

SEASON OF ADVENT: The word “Advent” comes from Latin word “advenire” to come; its purpose is to look forward to the coming of Christ to Earth; it was a season that focused on waiting. So, “Advent means something new is coming. The dawn of a new and better era. This is already what the Christmas season is all about, isn’t it. It’s the celebration of the Advent of a new era. God broke into time and space and entered our world.” Through prayer we can enter into God’s world and ask Him to prepare our hearts the way. He prepared all of history to receive the gift of His Son. Ask the father to use this time during Advent to cut away the distractions and make your life a place of warmth and openness. We’ve compiled these Advent prayers from across our archives to help you make sure there’s room at the inn” of your heart this year.

WEEK 1, HOPE: Dear Jesus, you are the hope of our messy world. This Advent, help us slow down, listen to your voice and focus on what’s really important. We place our hope in you as we prepare our hearts to celebrate your birth on Christmas. Amen

WEEK 2, PEACE: Dear Jesus, you entered our world on Christmas as the Prince of Peace. This Advent, as we strive to become the best-version of-ourselves, fill us with a deep and abiding peace. Help us share that peace with everyone we encounter, especially those who need it most. Amen.

*****CATECHISM IN A YEAR*****

98. What does the virginal conception of Jesus mean? The virginal conception of Jesus means that Jesus was conceived in the womb of the Virgin solely by the power of the Holy Spirit without the intervention of a man. He is the Son of the heavenly Father according to his divine nature and the Son of Mary according to his human nature. He is however, truly the Son of God in both natures since there is in him only one Person who is divine.

99. In what sense is Mary "ever Virgin"? Mary is ever virgin in the sense that she "remained a virgin in conceiving her Son, a virgin in giving birth to him, a virgin in carrying him, a virgin in nursing him at her breast, always a virgin" (Saint Augustine). Therefore, when the Gospels speak of the "brothers and sisters of Jesus", they are talking about the close relations of Jesus, according to the way of speaking used in Sacred Scripture.

100. In what way is the spiritual motherhood of Mary universal? Mary had only one Son, Jesus, but in him her spiritual motherhood extends to all whom he came to save. Obediently standing at the side of the new Adam, Jesus Christ, the Virgin is the *new Eve*, the true mother of all the living, who with a mother's love cooperates in their birth and their formation in the order of grace. Virgin and Mother, Mary is the figure of the Church, its most perfect realization.

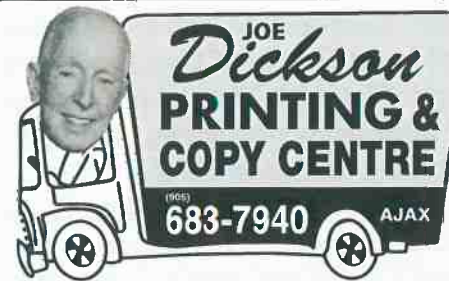
